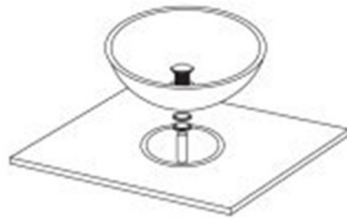


Glass Basins Installation Guide

For partial recess installation

Step 1:

Cut a bevelled edge hole to suit the diameter of the basin with certain angle (this has to be determined by your professional countertop fabricator), which allows your basin to be recessed into the hole at the required depth.

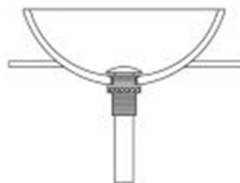


Step 2:

Apply silicone along the edge of the hole and press the basin down and adjust it into the correct position. Remove excess silicone after it cures from both above and underneath your basin.

Step 3:

From under the drain, insert the thick rubber washer, screw on the metal nut and hand tighten it.



Note:

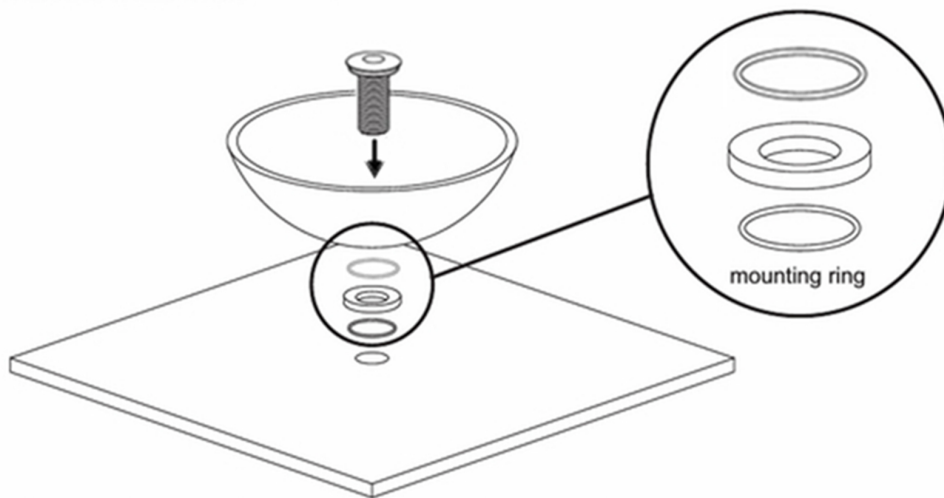
- The countertop shouldn't be thicker than 40mm due to the length of the drain supplied with the basin.

- Hand tight only. Over-tightening may break the basin.

ABOVE COUNTER INSTALLATION



STEP 1:

Carefully cut a waste hole to suit your above counter basin.

CAUTION - Please also cut a tap hole to suit your mixer tap unless you are using a wall mounted basin mixer.

STEP 2:

Carefully position the basin in the cut-out opening.

CAUTION - Please placing the mounting ring (if you have) on the counter-top before positioning the basin.

STEP 3: Use moderate force and hand-tighten the drain kit to secure your basin on the counter-top.

CAUTION - Do not over tighten drain assembly as this may cause the bowl to crack during installation, or at some time in the future due to excessive tightening or force.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

For best results in caring your glass basin, we suggest:

- Never use strong /abrasive cleaner. Always test your cleaning solution on unnoticeable area before applying to the entire surface.
- Wipe surfaces clean, immediately after applying cleaner.
- Do not allow cleaner to sit or soak. Never let cleaners sit on the surface of the glass.
- Use a soft, dampened sponge or cloth. Never use abrasive materials such as brushes or scouring pad to clean the surface. They will scratch the glass.
- Always rinse and wipe clean the fixtures to prevent soap build-up.
